I. Old Business

The meeting participants accepted the September meeting minutes as presented; the minutes will be posted at the Website.

Brian projected the Berks-Lancaster-Lebanon Link Website (www.berkslancasterlebanonlink.org) on a screen and demonstrated the some of the drop-down items. He reminded those in attendance to refer to the Website for cross-training meeting information, agendas and minutes.

He also encouraged everyone send events and happenings at their separate agencies for posting at the Website. Additionally, he asked the partners to



share their comments, suggestions and comments to make the Website more useful for them and for the populations the Link serves:

Brian reported that Joe Kozak's WRAP®: Wellness Recovery Action Plan sessions began yesterday at the Lebanon Community Library.

II. Cross-training program

This month's cross-training presenters, **Stacia Dial** and **Mike Ritter**, captured the attention of the meeting participants.

Stacia enlightened everyone about the services and offerings at StoneRidge Living, but she also shared very interesting tips and caveats that families and people considering a retirement living home ought to aware of. Her presentation was compelling and scintillating.

Mike's passionate presentation on recognizing Domestic Violence and working to be part of the resolution solution was equally stimulating. Mike asked the meeting attendees to be part of the 20:1 ratio and become a



blocking agent against domestic violence. October is National Domestic Awareness Month.

III. New Business

Brian asked those in attendance to if they knew of possible <u>venues for</u> <u>meetings in 2015</u>.

Brian informed the meeting participants about plans to have Link partners CEU producing workshops for Link partners on the topics of (1) social capital; (2) ethics in social work; (3) LGBT awareness as people age and other topics.
