ONLY ONE SOLUTION

- PA currently supports a **\$39 state/federal daily Supplemental Security Income (SSI) payment to support low-income individuals in PCHs.** (That is less than \$1,195 per month!)
- Of that \$39, **PA only contributes \$14.44!**
- But that payment hasn't increased since 2006 & more than **410 PCHs have closed** since 2008.
- **Current providers** still accepting the Supplement **are one crisis away from closure;** they struggle to maintain their properties, stay current on utilities, and retain qualified staff, especially in light of the last 2 years.
- **Personal Care Homes are the least restrictive, most healthcare-dollar effective homes with supportive care.**
- ALPHA (Alliance for Low-Income Personal Care Homes Advancement) is a collaborative statewide organization that promotes the sustainability of low-income personal care homes through volunteerism, advocacy, partnerships, and business mentoring.
