ONLY ONE SOLUTION

- PA currently supports a \$39 state/federal daily
 Supplemental Security Income (SSI) payment
 to support low-income individuals in PCHs.
 (That is less than \$1,195 per month!)
- Of that \$39, PA only contributes \$14.44!
- But that payment hasn't increased since 2006
 & more than 410 PCHs have closed since 2008.
- Current providers still accepting the
 Supplement are one crisis away from closure;
 they struggle to maintain their properties, stay
 current on utilities, and retain qualified staff,
 especially in light of the last 2 years.
- Personal Care Homes are the least restrictive, most healthcare-dollar effective homes with supportive care.
- ALPHA (Alliance for Low-Income Personal Care Homes Advancement) is a collaborative statewide organization that promotes the sustainability of low-income personal care homes through volunteerism, advocacy, partnerships, and business mentoring.
